Subject : PROGRESS REPORT OF MOBILE LIBRARY FOR THE MONTH OF July '15

I am pleased to submit our progress report of mobile library operation in **Kaw Hmu, Nay Pyi Taw and Kalaw** for the month of July 2015.

I. Kaw Hmu Mobile Library Operation

I.A Membership

Below is our membership status:

Big Bus	- 5,953
Central Lib	- 6,296
Small Bus	- 4,182
Sub-Centre	- <u>1,251</u>
Total	17,682

Kalaw membership had increased by 90%

Kalaw circulation increased 2.27 times.

Kaw Hmu will reach to 2 years in Operation in July '15 and will reach to 250,000 checkouts.

English language training classes for Grade 10 will start in Kaw Hmu in 2 weeks time.

Membership rate was 4% increase comparing with June '15. Please see below chart which shows the current membership status as at end of July '15.

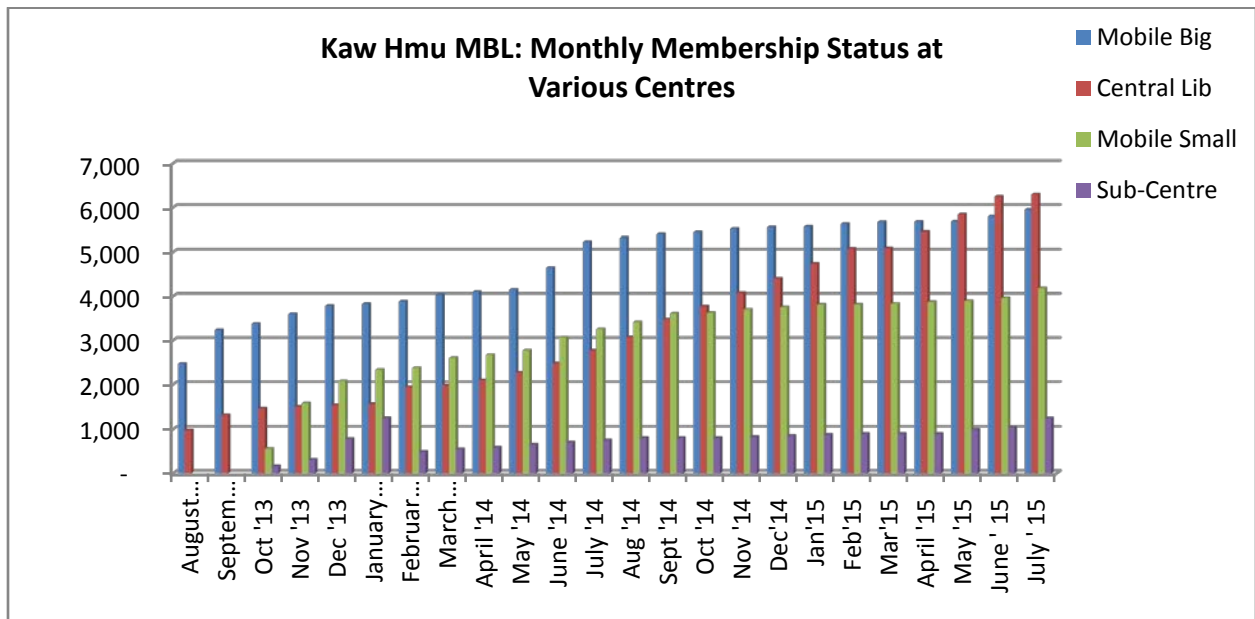
I.B Circulation

At present, (22,768) books have been catalogued and are in circulation in Kaw Hmu. Circulation of the books during the month of July 2015 is shown as follows:

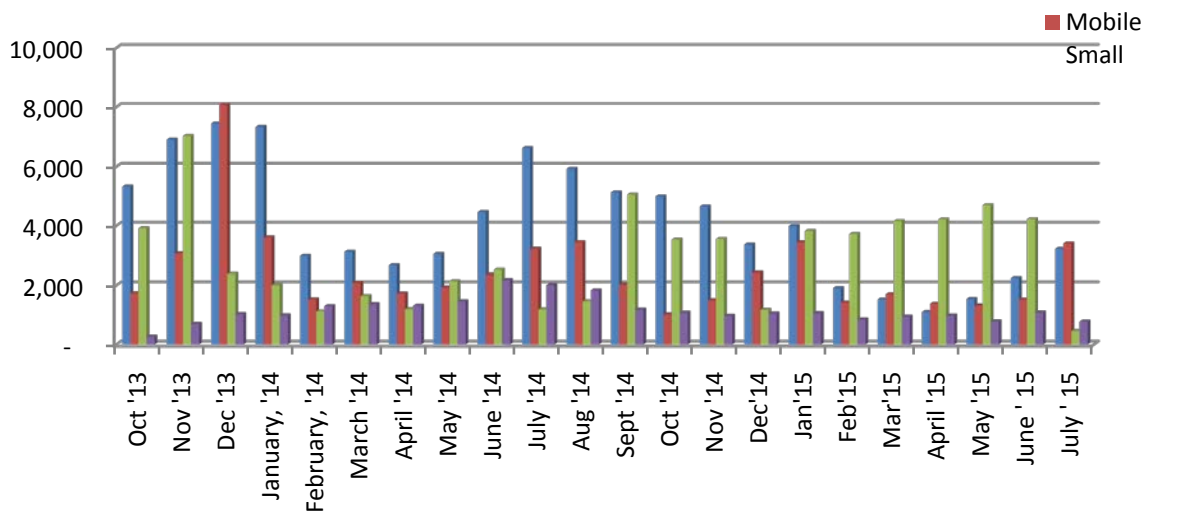
- 1. Mobile Big Bus : 3,219
- 2. Mobile Small Bus : 3,399
- 3. Central Library : 459
- 4. Sub-centre : 778
- Total : 7,855**

Therefore, there is 13.5 % reduction in circulation comparing with June 2015 in Kaw Hmu. Kaw Hmu had reached to 239,863 in total circulation from July 2013 to July 2015 (in 25 months time) .

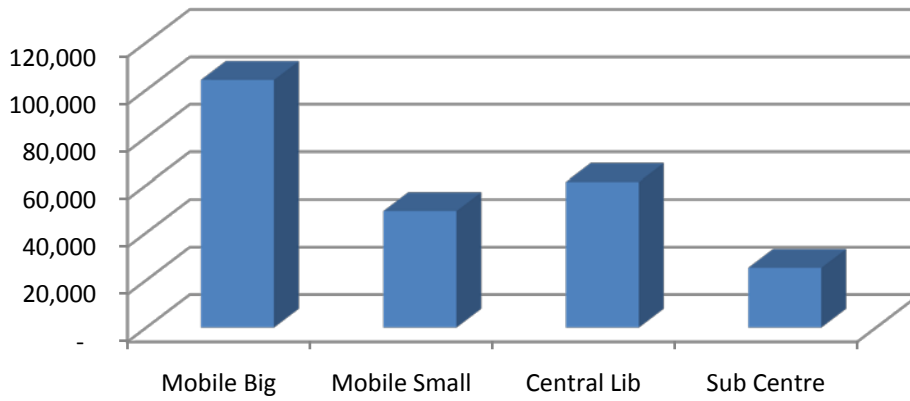

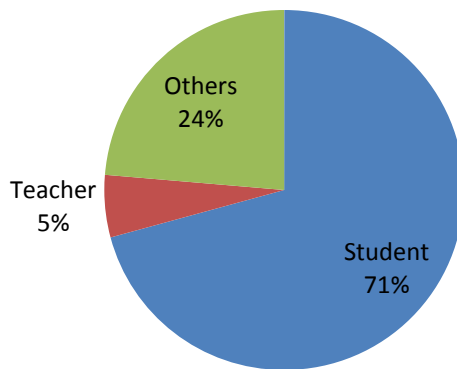
Kaw Hmu MBL: Monthly Circulation Status at Various Centres for Past One Year

II. Nay Pyi Taw Mobile Library Operation

Nay Pyi Taw operation is running well in July 2015 too. At present, (15,257) books has been catalogued and are in circulation in Nay Pyi Taw .

II.A Membership

Below is Membership Status as at end of July 2015 in Nay Pyi Taw. Current membership status is as follows:

1. Mobile Big : 7,947
 2. Mobile Small: 3,240
- Grand Total : 11,187**

Detail breakdown of the user status is as follows:

1. Students : 6,805
 2. Teacher : 186
 3. Community : 4,196
- Total : 11,187**

There is 2% increase in membership number comparing with June 2015.

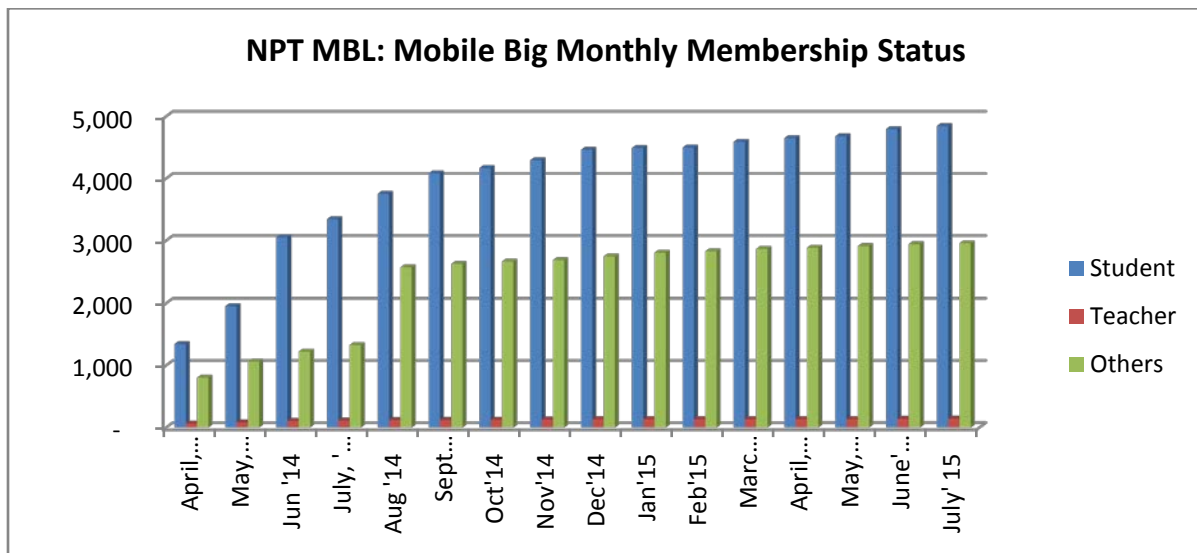
II.B Circulation

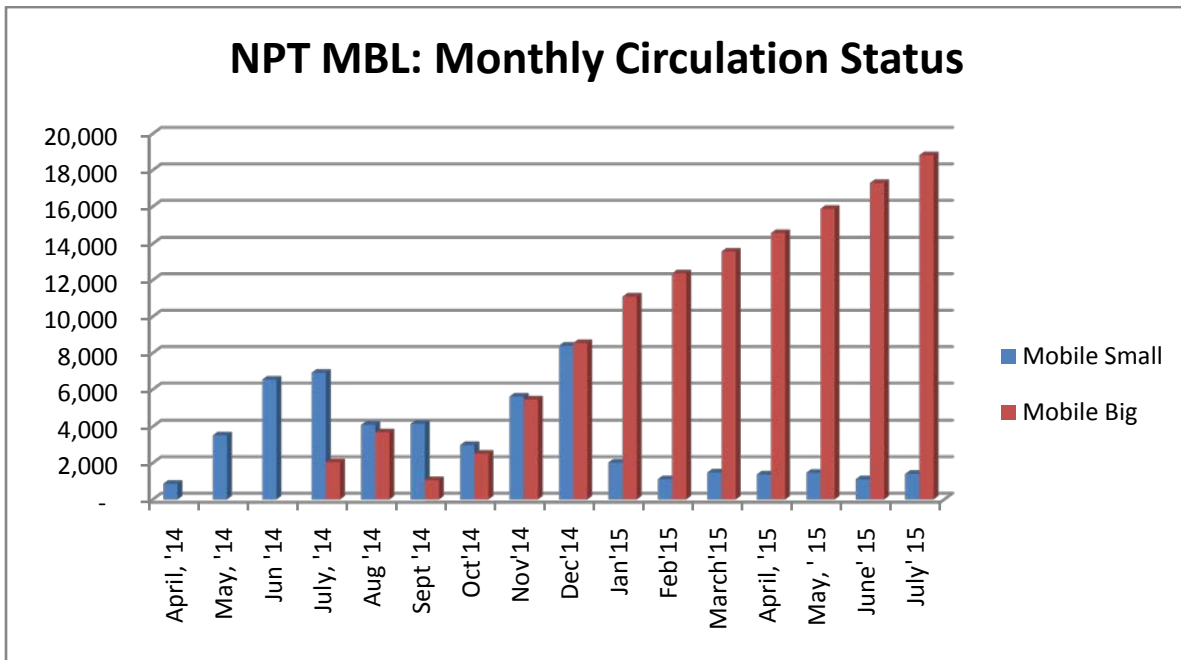
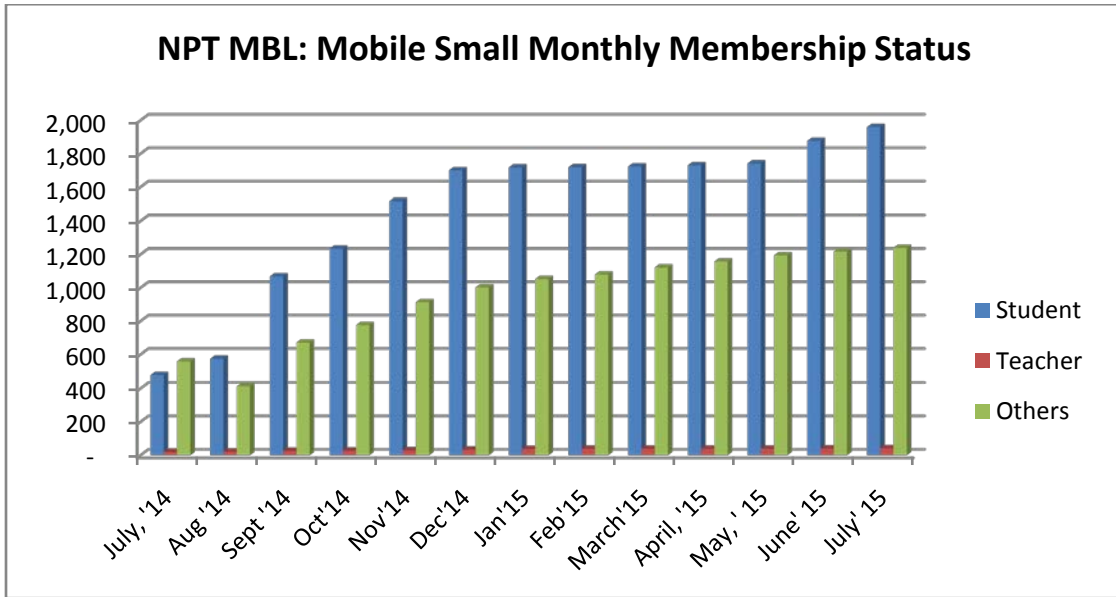
Over 15,257 books are in circulation in Nay Pyi Taw Office. 20,213 books were checked out during the month of July 2015. Therefore, there is 10 % increase in circulation comparing with June'15. We are reaching to 179,793 in total circulation in just 17 months.

We are providing our service to 48 villages via the two mobile buses. We now have 3 sub-centres in Nay Pyi Taw.

III. Kalaw Mobile Library Operation

7,872 books are in circulation. We are reaching to (42) places which include libraries, community gathering places and offices also. Membership is reduced by 60% comparing with June '15 and it is mainly due to flooding in Kalaw so that we can't get more members.

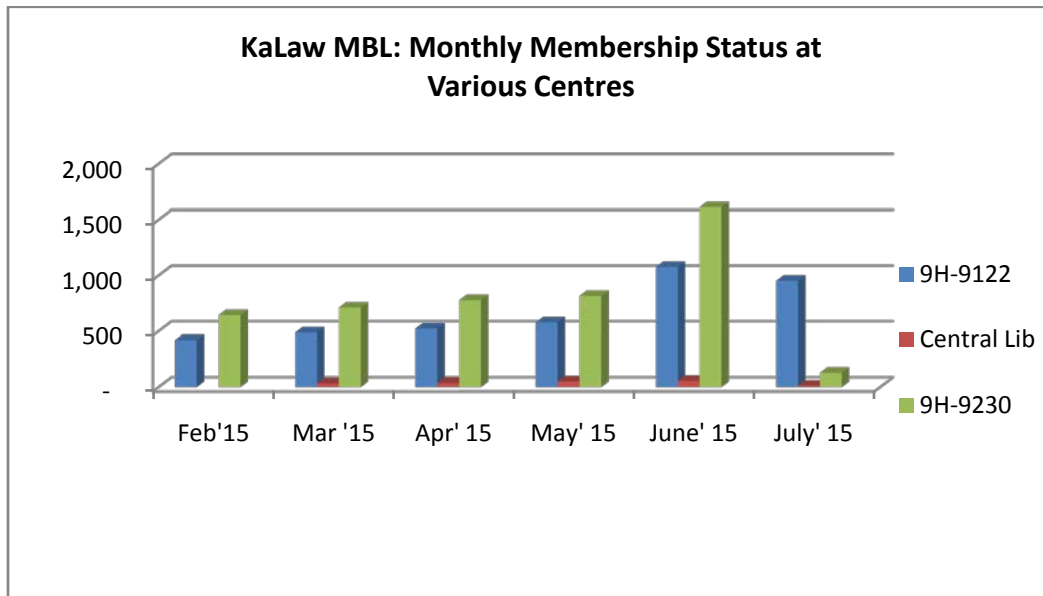

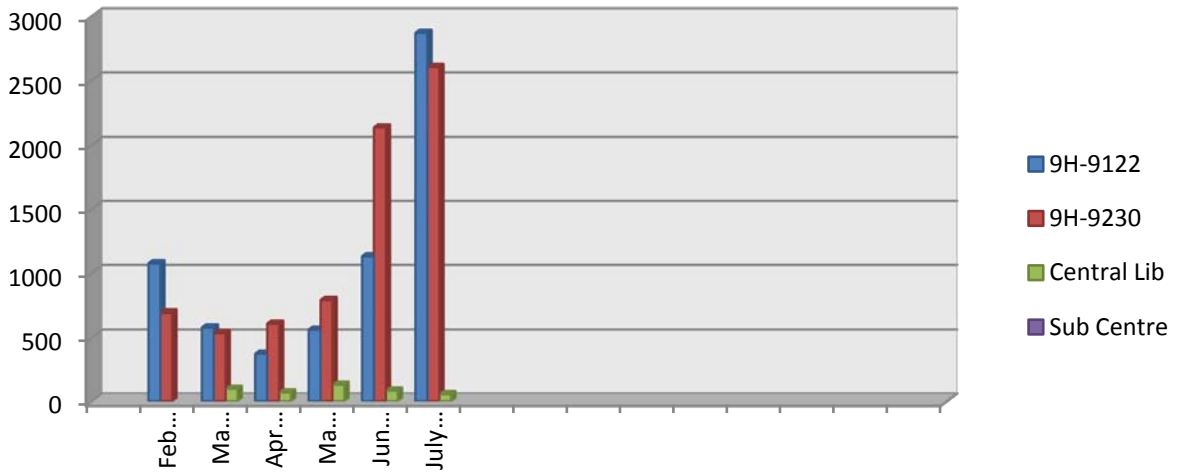

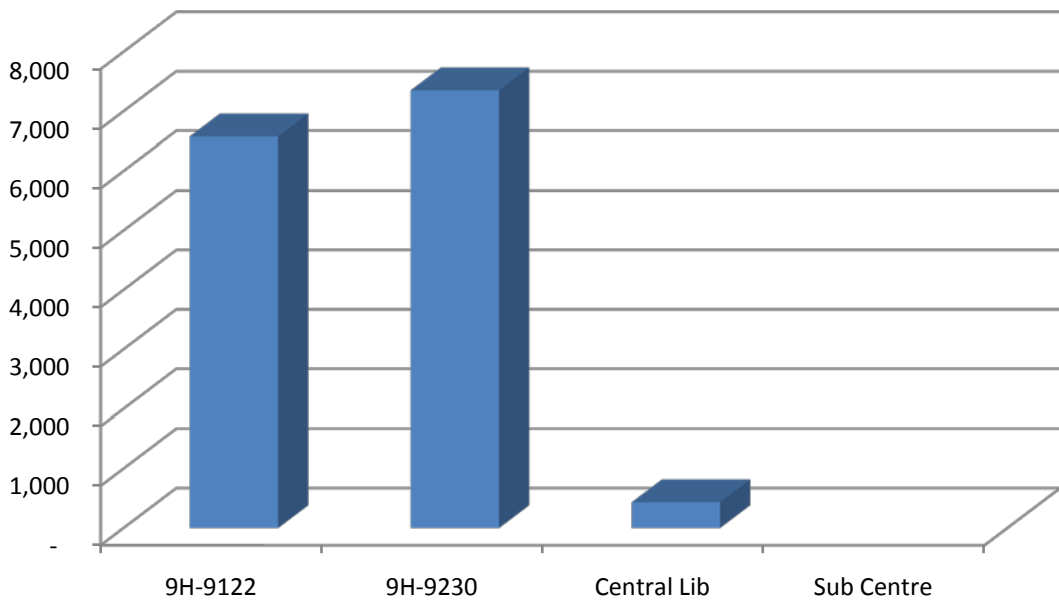
There is **60% reduction in membership and 65% increase in circulation**. This is because we can't get new members due to flooding but existing members borrow many more books and hence the circulation is up. Total of 37,427 books have been checked out from February to July 2015 and we are hoping to see more improvement in the coming months.



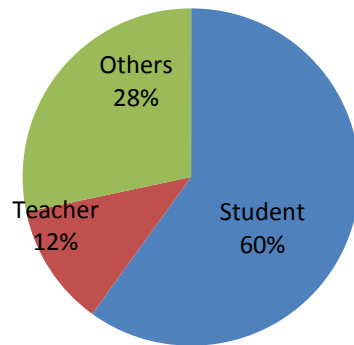
KaLaw MBL: Monthly Circulation Status at Various Centres for Past One Year

The operation was launched on 8th August. It is fortunate that there is no flooding in Nat Mauk and hence the operation can be run smoothly.

We are able to open up computer training classes at all the centres; Kaw Hmu, Kalaw and Nat Mauk. Hopefully, we can open a centre at Nay Pyi Taw soon.

IV c. English Language Training

Even though we tried to open English language training at Kaw Hmu, very few students turned up to register. We later found out that they have already registered at private tuitions. But, we think we can open a class from coming week onwards.

In conclusion, the MBL project and its various activities in both Kaw Hmu, Nay Pyi Taw, Kalaw and Nat Mauk are operating smoothly and successfully.
