I am pleased to submit our progress report of mobile library **operation in Kaw Hmu and Nay Pyi Taw** for the month of November 2014.

I. Kaw Hmu Mobile Library Operation

I.A Membership

Below is our membership status:

Big Bus	- 5,516
Small Bus	- 3,700
Central Lib	- 4,078
Sub-Centre	- <u>828</u>
Total	14,122

500 people are learning basic computer training skills

70% of readers are students.

5% increase in both membership and circulation in NPT

Membership rate was 3.5% increase comparing with October '14. Please see below chart shows the current membership status as at end of November '14.

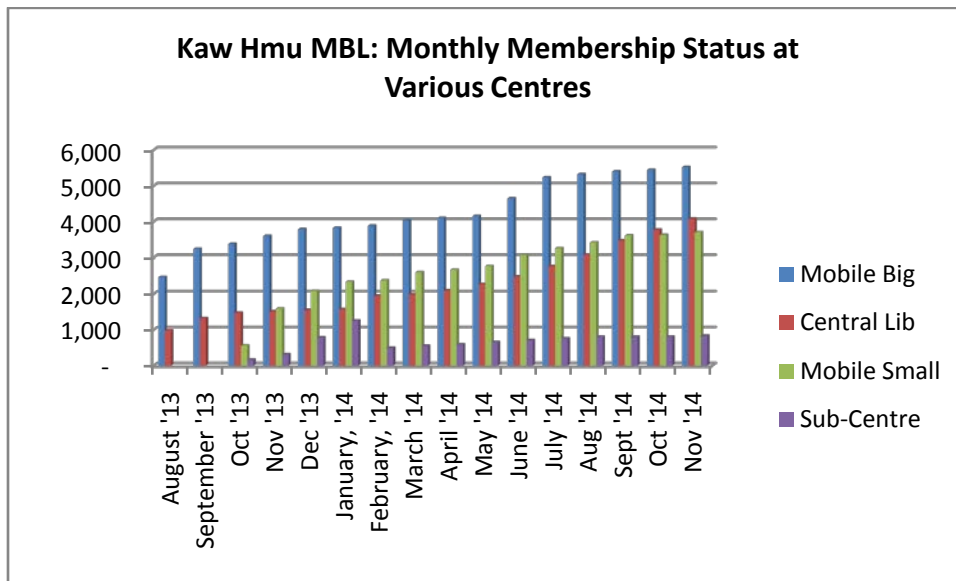
I.B Circulation

At present, (21,564) books have been catalogued and are in circulation in Kaw Hmu. Circulation of the books during the month of November 2014 is shown as follows:

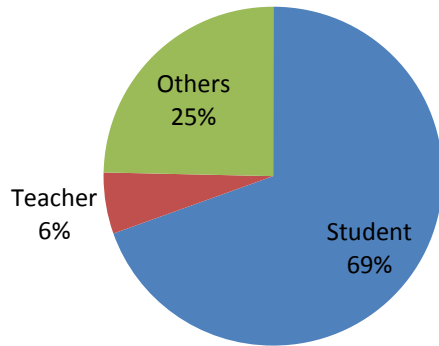
1. Mobile Big Bus : 4,654
 2. Mobile Small Bus : 1,499
 3. Central Library : 3,551
 4. Sub-centre : 971
- Total : 10,617**

Therefore, there is 1.5% increase in circulation comparing with October '14 in Kaw Hmu. At present, we are covering 39 villages in Kaw Hmu and detail breakdown is as follows. We are able to cover for two more villages this month.

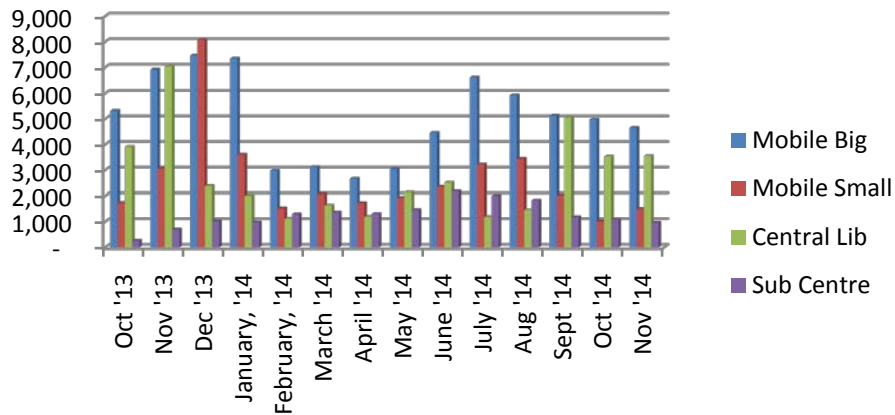

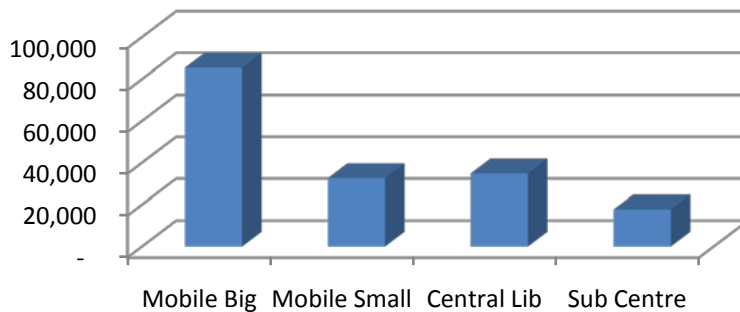
Kaw Hmu MBL: Percentage of Type of Membership

II. Nay Pyi Taw Mobile Library Operation

Nay Pyi Taw operation is running very well in November 2014 too. At present, (14,271) books has been catalogued and are in circulation in Nay Pyi Taw .

II.A Membership

Below is Membership Status as at end of November '14 in Nay Pyi Taw. Current membership status is as follows:

1. Students : 5,813
2. Teacher : 160
3. Community : 3,598

There is 6.4% increase in membership number comparing with October '14.

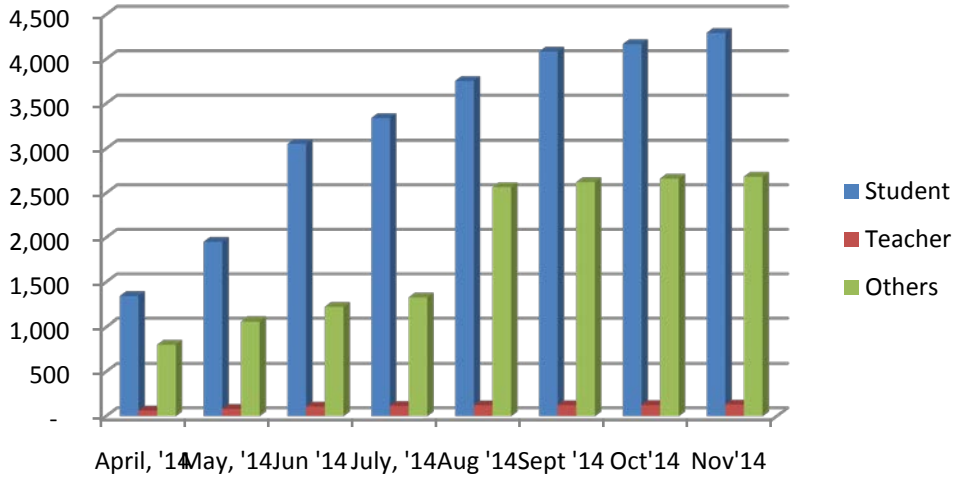
II.B Circulation

Over 11,053 books were checkout during the month of November '14. Therefore, there is 201.73% increase in circulation comparing with October '14. This is a huge success in circulation in Nay Pyi Taw as there is over double in circulation.

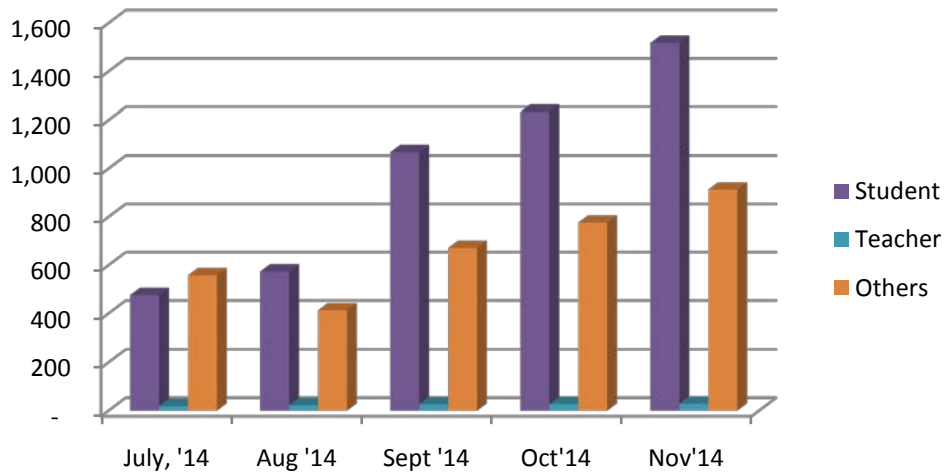
We are able to provide service to 34 villages. We are able to expand our NPT operation by visiting to 25 villages comparing with 20 villages in October. That is why, our circulation number had increased over two folds.

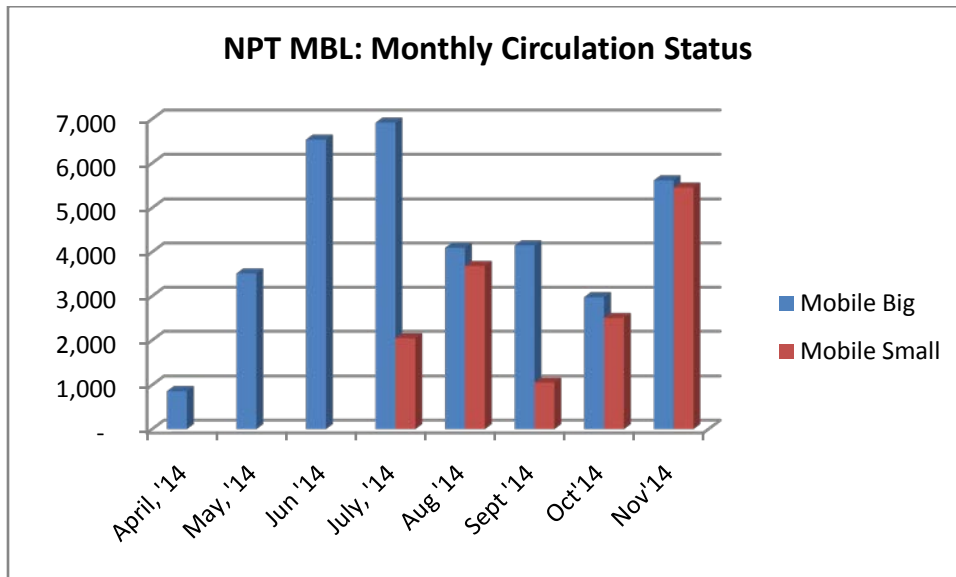

Out of the (3) mobile schools, Than Lysin school performance is outstanding. (3) sessions are currently being opened. Total of (90) students are attending now. Internet will be available very soon in this centre and we are hoping that more and more people will be attending at the centre.



III.B Kalaw Project : Boxes have been fixed on the truck and we are now setting up office and recruiting staffs for Kalaw Office. We hope we can launch the project in January '15.
